

FINES AND PENALTIES BILL 2023

Explanatory Memorandum

1. This Bill is promoted by Hon. John Wannenburg, MHK.
2. *Clause 1* provides for the short title to the Bill.
3. *Clause 2* provides for the Bill's commencement.
4. *Clauses 3 to 8* apply where a fine or penalty is imposed on summary conviction.
5. *Clause 3* provides that amounts in the statutory provisions in the table in Schedule 1 which are, by virtue of section 55 of the *Interpretation Act 2015*, to be read as level 1 on the standard scale substitute (by textual amendment) "level 1 on the standard scale" (i.e. a fine not exceeding £500).
6. *Clause 4* provides that amounts in the statutory provisions in the table in Schedule 2 which are, by virtue of section 55 of the *Interpretation Act 2015*, to be read as level 2 on the standard scale substitute (by textual amendment) "level 2 on the standard scale" (i.e. a fine not exceeding £1,000).
7. *Clause 5* provides that amounts in the statutory provisions in the table in Schedule 3 which are, by virtue of section 55 of the *Interpretation Act 2015*, to be read as level 3 on the standard scale substitute (by textual amendment) "level 3 on the standard scale" (i.e. a fine not exceeding £2,000).
8. *Clause 6* provides that amounts in the statutory provisions in the table in Schedule 4 which are, by virtue of section 55 of the *Interpretation Act 2015*, to be read as level 4 on the standard scale substitute (by textual amendment) "level 4 on the standard scale" (i.e. a fine not exceeding £5,000).
9. *Clause 7* provides that amounts in the statutory provisions in the table in Schedule 5 which are, by virtue of section 55 of the *Interpretation Act 2015*, to be read as level 5 on the standard scale substitute (by textual amendment) "level 5 on the standard scale" (i.e. a fine not exceeding £10,000).
10. *Clause 8* makes amendments to a number of statutory provisions referred to in Schedule 6 including —
 - (a) changing the statutory language from a numerical amount of a fine or penalty to a fine or penalty by reference to the standard scale, and
 - (b) omitting certain fines and penalties payable at a daily rate.
11. *Clause 9* omits sections 1 and 2 and amends section 3 of Part 1 (increases in fines etc.) of the *Criminal Justice (Penalties, Etc.) Act 1993*.
12. *Clause 10* repeals (in its entirety) the *Fines Act 1986*.

13. In the opinion of the member moving the Bill its provisions are compatible with the Convention rights within the meaning of the Human Rights Act 2001.

FINES AND PENALTIES BILL 2023

- 1 **A BILL** to modernise references in Acts of Tynwald to fines and penalties
2 imposed on summary conviction and to amend certain provisions relating to
3 daily fines or penalties in such legislation; and for connected purposes.

BE IT ENACTED by the King’s Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Council and Keys in Tynwald assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

4 **1 Short title**

5 The short title of this Act is the Fines and Penalties Act 2023.

6 **2 Commencement**

7 (1) This Act, except sections 9 and 10, commences on Royal Assent to it
8 being announced to Tynwald.

9 (2) Sections 9 and 10 come into operation on such day or days as the
10 Department of Home Affairs by order appoint.

11 Tynwald procedure — laying only.

12 (3) An order under subsection (2) may include such consequential,
13 incidental, supplementary, transitional and transitory provision as the
14 Department of Home Affairs considers necessary or expedient.

15 **3 Level 1**

16 For an amount in the statutory provisions referred to in the Table in Schedule 1
17 which, by virtue section 55 of the *Interpretation Act 2015*, is to be read as “level 1
18 on the standard scale” substitute “level 1 on the standard scale”.

19 **4 Level 2**

20 For an amount in the statutory provisions referred to in the Table in Schedule 2
21 which, by virtue section 55 of the *Interpretation Act 2015*, is to be read as “level 2
22 on the standard scale” substitute “level 2 on the standard scale”.

1 **5 Level 3**

2 For an amount in the statutory provisions referred to in the Table in Schedule 3
3 which, by virtue section 55 of the *Interpretation Act 2015*, is to be read as “level 3
4 on the standard scale” substitute “level 3 on the standard scale”.

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6 **6 Level 4**

7 For an amount in the statutory provisions referred to in the Table in Schedule 4
8 which, by virtue section 55 of the *Interpretation Act 2015*, is to be read as “level 4
9 on the standard scale” substitute “level 4 on the standard scale”.

10 **7 Level 5**

11 For an amount in the statutory provisions referred to in the Table in Schedule 5
12 which, by virtue section 55 of the *Interpretation Act 2015*, is to be read as “level 5
13 on the standard scale” substitute “level 5 on the standard scale”.

14 **8 Further amendments**

15 Schedule 6 contains further amendments relating to fines and penalties and has
16 effect for that purpose.

17 **9 Consequential amendments**

18 (1) The *Criminal Justice (Penalties, Etc.) Act 1993* is amended as follows.

19 (2) Omit sections 1 and 2.

20 (3) In section 3 —

21 (a) after subsection (1), insert —

22 “(1A) Subsection (1) does not apply to a fine which may be imposed on
23 summary conviction for an offence.”;

24 (b) omit subsections (2) and (3A);

25 (c) in subsections (3) and (4) omit “or (2)”.

26 **10 Repeals**

27 The *Fines Act 1986* is repealed.
