THE FILING OF STATUTORY DOCUMENTS ACT 1937

AN ACT to require statutory regulations, bye-laws, orders, etc., to be filed in the Rolls Office.

GENERAL NOTE: References to the Rolls Office are to be construed in accordance with the *General Registry Act 1965*.

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as 'The Filing of Statutory Documents Act, 1937'.

2 Statutory documents to be filed in Rolls Office

- (1) All documents duly executed making or purporting to make bye-laws, regulations or orders having the effect of law now in force or at any time hereafter made by any Department, Local Authority or other body empowered by Act of Tynwald to make any such bye-laws, regulations or orders shall be filed in the Rolls Office with all reasonable despatch.¹
- (2) No fee shall be payable in respect of the filing of any such documents.

3 Commencement of Act

This Act shall come into operation when the Royal Assent thereto has been by the Governor announced to Tynwald and a certificate thereof has been signed by the Governor and the Speaker of the House of Keys.
