THE SEEDS AMENDMENT ACT 1939

Received Royal Assent: 3 July 1939
Passed: 4 August 1939
Commenced: 4 August 1939

AN ACT to amend the Seeds Act, 1921.

GENERAL NOTE: The maximum fines in this Act are as increased by the *Fines Act 1986* and by the *Criminal Justice (Penalties, Etc.) Act 1993* s 1.

1 Short title and construction

This Act may be cited as ‘The Seeds Amendment Act, 1939’ and shall be construed as one with The Seeds Act, 1921, and such Act and this Act may together be cited as ‘The Seeds Acts, 1921 to 1939’.

2 [Amends section 12 of the *Seeds Act 1921*.]

3 Obtaining of information

The Department or the Agricultural Organiser or Secretary, or other officer of the Department duly authorised in this behalf, may require any person who sells seeds, or seed potatoes, or who has seeds or seed potatoes, for sale, to supply to the Department or such officer in writing such particulars as he may be called upon to supply, and to produce to the Department or such officer such invoices, delivery notes, or other documents relating to such seeds, or seed potatoes, as may be required. Any person failing to give, or refusing to give, such particulars, or produce such documents within three days after being so required shall be liable on summary conviction at the suit of the Department to a fine not exceeding £500.¹

4 Proceedings by the Department

In any proceedings by the Department for an offence under the Seeds Acts, 1921 to 1939, the Department may appear by the secretary of the Department, or any other officer authorised by the Department in that behalf.²

5 Commencement of Act

This Act shall come into operation when the Royal Assent thereto has been by the Governor announced to Tynwald and a certificate thereof has been signed by the Governor and the Speaker of the House of Keys.
