

Immigration and Social Security Co-ordination (EU Withdrawal) Act 2020

2020 CHAPTER 20

An Act to make provision to end rights to free movement of persons under retained EU law and to repeal other retained EU law relating to immigration; to confer power to modify retained direct EU legislation relating to social security co-ordination; and for connected purposes.

[11th November 2020]

Provisions of the Immigration and Social Security Co-ordination (EU Withdrawal) Act 2020 (of Parliament) may be extended to the Isle of Man, with modifications, as provided for in section 8(2) of the Act.

- “(2) Her Majesty may by Order in Council provide for any of the provisions of Part 1 of this Act, and of sections 7 and 10 (so far as relating to that Part), to extend, with or without modifications, to—
- (a) any of the Channel Islands;
 - (b) the Isle of Man;
 - (c) any of the British overseas territories.”
