BARCLAYS BANK (ISLE OF MAN) ACT, 1969, (APPOINTED
DAY) ORDER, 1969.

WHEREAS it is enacted by Section 13(2) of the
Barclays Bank (Isle of Man) Act, 1969 that the Act
shall take effect on the appointed day.

AND WHEREAS under Section 12(1) of the said
Act, "the appointed day" means such date as may be
appointed by Order of the Governor made on the
application of Barclays Bank Limited.

AND WHEREAS the said Barclays Bank Limited have
requested that the Barclays Bank (Isle of Man) Act
1969 shall take effect on the 15th December, 1969.

NOW, therefore, I, the said Lieutenant
Governor by virtue and in exercise of the powers
conferred on me as aforesaid, DO hereby order as
follows:-

1. The Appointed Day for all the purposes of the
said Act shall be the 15th December, 1969.
2. This Order may be cited as the Barclays
Bank (Isle of Man) Act, 1969 (Appointed Day)
Order, 1969.
