WILDLIFE ACT 1990 (APPOINTED DAY) (NO. 1) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry by section 41(2) and (3) of the Wildlife Act 1990(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Wildlife Act 1990 (Appointed Day) (No. 1) Order 1990.

Appointed day

2. (1) Subject to paragraphs (2) to (4), the following provisions of the Wildlife Act 1990 (in this article referred to as "the Act") shall come into operation on the 1st January 1991 -

- (a) sections 1 to 5;
- (b) sections 8 to 14;
- (b) sections 16 to 41;
- (c) Schedules 1 to 8;
- (d) Schedule 10.

(2) Sections 1 to 8 of the Act shall not come into operation as respects any district defined in any order under section 11 of the Wild Birds Protection Act 1932(b) which was in force immediately before the 1st January 1991.

(3) The repeal of the Wild Birds Protection Acts 1932 to 1975 by Schedule 10 to the Act shall not come into operation as respects any district referred to in paragraph (2).

(4) The coming into operation of Schedule 10 to the Act shall not extend to the entry relating to the Endangered Species (Import and Export) Act 1981(c).

3. (1) In section 6 of the Act, subsections (1), (3) to (5) and (7) to (11) shall come into operation on 1st January 1991.

(2) Section 6(2) shall come into operation -

(a) on the 1st January 1991 to the extent necessary to enable regulations under that section to come into operation; and

(b) on the 1st April 1991 to its full extent.

(3) Section 6(6) shall come into operation -

(a) on the 1st January 1991 with the exception of the words from "and has been ringed" to the end of the subsection; and

(b) on 1st April 1991 to its full extent.

(4) This article is subject to article 2(2).

4. (1) In section 7 of the Act, subsections (2) to (10) shall come into operation on 1st January 1991.


(2) Section 7(1) shall come into operation -

(a) on the 1st January 1991 to the extent necessary to enable regulations under that section to come into operation; and

(b) on the 1st April 1991 to its full extent.

(3) This article is subject to article 2(2).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order brings the majority of the provisions of the Wildlife Act 1990 into force. The exceptions are -

WILDLIFE ACT 1990 (APPOINTED DAY) (NO. 1) ORDER 1990

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Wildlife Act 1990 (Appointed Day) (No. 1) Order 1990.

Appointed day

2. (1) Subject to paragraphs (2) to (4), the following provisions of the Wildlife Act 1990 (in this article referred to as "the Act") shall come into operation on the 1st January 1991 -

- (a) sections 1 to 5;
- (b) sections 8 to 14;
- (b) sections 16 to 41;
- (c) Schedules 1 to 8;
- (d) Schedule 10.

(2) Sections 1 to 8 of the Act shall not come into operation as respects any district defined in any order under section 11 of the Wild Birds Protection Act 1932(b) which was in force immediately before the 1st January 1991.

(3) The repeal of the Wild Birds Protection Acts 1932 to 1975 by Schedule 10 to the Act shall not come into operation as respects any district referred to in paragraph (2).

(4) The coming into operation of Schedule 10 to the Act shall not extend to the entry relating to the Endangered Species (Import and Export) Act 1981(c).

3. (1) In section 6 of the Act, subsections (1), (3) to (5) and (7) to (11) shall come into operation on 1st January 1991.

(2) Section 6(2) shall come into operation -

(a) on the 1st January 1991 to the extent necessary to enable regulations under that section to come into operation; and

(b) on the 1st April 1991 to its full extent.

(3) Section 6(6) shall come into operation -

(a) on the 1st January 1991 with the exception of the words from "and has been ringed" to the end of the subsection; and

(b) on 1st April 1991 to its full extent.

(4) This article is subject to article 2(2).

4. (1) In section 7 of the Act, subsections (2) to (10) shall come into operation on 1st January 1991.


(2) Section 7(1) shall come into operation -

(a) on the 1st January 1991 to the extent necessary to enable regulations under that section to come into operation; and

(b) on the 1st April 1991 to its full extent.

(3) This article is subject to article 2(2).
