*Merchant Shipping Registration Act 1991*

MERCHANT SHIPPING (RELEVANT COUNTRIES) REGULATIONS 1994¹

Approved by Tynwald: 19 October 1994
Coming into Operation: 1 July 1994

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by sections 45(1)(e) and (2), 60, 76(1) and 78(1) of the Merchant Shipping Registration Act 1991¹ and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the concurrence of the Secretary of State, the following Regulations is hereby made: —

1 Citation, commencement and interpretation

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Relevant Countries) Regulations 1994.
- (2) Subject to section 76 of the Act, these Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st July, 1994.
- (3) In these Regulations, "the Act" means the Merchant Shipping Registration Act 1991.

2 Relevant Countries

- (1) Member states (within the meaning of the European Communities (Isle of Man) Act 1973² are prescribed as relevant countries for the purposes of Part I of the Act (Registration of Manx Ships).
- (2) The countries prescribed under paragraph (1) are prescribed for the purposes of the determination of persons who are qualified under section 2 of the Act to own Manx ships and for no other purpose.
