



THE ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) ACT 2006

**The Road Traffic (Amendment) Act 2006
(Appointed Day) (No. 2) Order 2007**

Laid before Tynwald:

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by section 16(2) of the Road Traffic (Amendment) Act 2006¹, and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. Citation and interpretation

(1) This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Amendment) Act 2006 (Appointed Day) (No. 2) Order 2007.

(2) In this Order —

“the Act” means the Road Traffic (Amendment) Act 2006; and

“the 1985 Act” means the Road Traffic Act 1985²

Commencement of section 2 of the Act

2. Section 2 (newly qualified drivers) of the Act shall come into operation on 1st September 2007.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order brings into operation on 1st September 2007 Section 2 (newly qualified drivers) of the Road Traffic (Amendment) Act 2006 (c. 24).
