**ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE ACT 2008 (APPOINTED DAY)
ORDER 2008**

29 December 2008

The Council of Ministers makes this Order under section 34 of the Administration of Justice Act 2008¹.

1. Title

The title of this Order is the Administration of Justice Act 2008 (Appointed Day) Order 2008.

2. Interpretation

In this Order “the Act” means the Administration of Justice Act 2008.

3. Commencement of the Act: general

The Act comes into operation in accordance with articles 4 to 6.

4. Commencement of sections 25, 29, 30, 32 and 34

(1) The provisions of the Act listed in paragraph (2) come into operation for all purposes on 1st January 2009.

(2) The provisions are —

section 25 (oaths and affirmations);

section 29 (criminal appeals in respect of pre-trial rulings);

section 30 (which concerns changes to Tynwald procedure for rules of court);

section 32 (power of court of summary jurisdiction to remit payment of arrears); and

section 34 (citation and commencement).

5. **Commencement of section 31**

- (1) Section 31 of the Act (jury lists) comes into operation on 1st January 2009, but subject to paragraph (2).
- (2) Paragraph (1) does not affect the continuing operation until 31st August 2009 of sections 5 to 7 of the Jury Act 1980 as they stand immediately before the coming into operation of section 31 in relation to service on a jury before that date.

6. **Commencement of other provisions**

Except to the extent provided above, the Act comes into operation —

- (a) on 1st January 2009, for the purpose of making rules of court and practice directions and preparing or approving forms; and
- (b) on 1st September 2009 for all other purposes.

7. **Transitional provision in respect of salaries of Deemsters and Attorney General**

Until the making of the first determinations by the Governor in Council under section 57A(1) of the High Court Act 1991² (which is inserted by section 8 of the Act) —

- (a) a Deemster shall be entitled to salary at the rate payable by virtue of the last determination made under section 3 of the 1991 Act as it has effect immediately before 1st September 2009 ("the relevant date"); and
- (b) the Attorney General shall be entitled to salary at the rate of payment which applies immediately before the relevant date.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order brings certain provisions of the Administration of Justice Act 2008 into operation on 1st January 2009, subject to transitional provisions in relation to the salaries of certain Crown appointees and savings in relation to the maintenance of jury lists for the year ending 31st August 2009. The rest of the Act is brought into operation on 1st January 2009 for the purposes of making rules of court etc. and on 1st September 2009 for all other purposes.
