Cash in Postal Packets Act 2013

CASH IN POSTAL PACKETS ACT 2013 (APPOINTED DAY) (NO. 1) ORDER 2013

Laid before Tynwald:

Coming into Operation: in accordance with article 3

The Treasury makes the following Order under section 2 of the Cash in Postal Packets Act 2013¹.

1 Title

This Order is the Cash in Postal Packets Act 2013 (Appointed Day) (No. 1) Order 2013.

2 Interpretation

In this Order, “**the Act**” means the Cash in Postal Packets Act 2013.

3 Commencement of sections 13, 15 and 17 of the Act

- (1) Section 17 of the Act comes into operation on 27 March 2013.
- (2) Consequently —
 - (a) section 15 of the Act comes into operation on 27 March 2013 for the purposes of enabling the Department of Home Affairs to make a code of practice in connection with the exercise of powers conferred by section 43A² of the Proceeds of Crime Act 2008³ and to bring that code into operation by order; and
 - (b) section 13 of the Act comes into operation on 27 March 2013 for the purposes of bringing sections 15 and 17 of the Act into operation in accordance with this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order designates the 27 March 2013 as the day on which section 17 of the Cash in Postal Packets Act 2013 (“the Act”) comes into operation, which enables the Department of Home Affairs to make the required code of practice relating to searches of postal packets permitted under section 43A of the Proceeds of Crime Act 2008 (section 43A being inserted into that Act by section 15 of the Act) and to bring the code into operation by order.

The Order also brings into operation on 27 March 2013 for the following purposes —

- section 15, for the purpose of making the code of practice and the order bringing the code into operation; and
- section 13, which provides for the amendment of the Proceeds of Crime Act 2008, for the purposes of bringing sections 15 and 17 into operation in accordance with this Order.
