*Payment of Members' Expenses Act 1989*

MEMBERS OF TYNWALD (ANNUAL SUMS) ORDER 2014¹

Approved by Tynwald: 19 March 2014
Coming into Operation: 1 April 2014

The Treasury, after consultation with the Standing Committee of Tynwald on Emoluments, makes the following Order under sections 1, 2 and 6(1) and (2A) of the Payment of Members' Expenses Act 1989.

1 Title

This Order is the Members of Tynwald (Annual Sums) Order 2014.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald, this Order comes into operation on 1 April 2014¹.

3 Annual payments to members of Tynwald

- (1) The annual sum payable to a Member of the House of Keys and the President of Tynwald is the amount at the mid-point between spine points 40 and 41 of the Public Services Commission Pay Scales, as determined by the Public Services Commission, as that pay scale has effect from time to time.
- (2) The annual sum payable to a Member of the Legislative Council, excluding a Member of the Legislative Council elected as the President of Tynwald, is the amount at spine point 39 of the Public Services Commission Pay Scales, as determined by the Public Services Commission, as that pay scale has effect from time to time.
- (3) Subject to paragraph 4 the annual sum payable to a member in accordance with paragraphs (1) or (2) who holds an office specified in column 1 of the table set out in the Schedule is subject to the percentage increase specified in column 2 of the table for that office holder.

- (4) The annual sum payable to a member who occupies more than one office specified in the table set out in the Schedule is increased by the highest applicable percentage increase only.²

4 Annual payments to the chairmen of certain Statutory Boards

- (1) Subject to paragraph (2) the annual sum payable to a member in accordance with article 3(1) or 3(2) who is a chairman of a Statutory Board specified in column 1 of the table set out in the Schedule is subject to the percentage increase specified in column 2 of the table for that office.
- (2) The annual sum payable to a member who occupies more than one office specified in the table set out in the Schedule is increased by the highest applicable percentage increase only.³

5 Revocations

The following orders are revoked –

- (a) the Members of Tynwald (Annual Sums) Order 2008²; and
- (b) the Members of Tynwald (Annual Sums) Order 2011³.

| Chair of the Manx Utilities Authority | 5 per cent |
| Chair of the Office of Fair Trading | 5 per cent |
| Chair of the Isle of Man Post Office | 5 per cent |
