*Bank Holidays Act 1989***BANK HOLIDAYS ORDER 2019¹***Laid before Tynwald: 16th July 2019**Coming into Operation: 1 January 2020*

The Treasury makes the following Order under section 1(2) of the Bank Holidays Act 1989.

1 Title

This Order is the Bank Holidays Order 2019.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation on 1 January 2020.

3 Bank Holidays

- (1) The following days are bank holidays in every year —
- (a) New Year's Day, if a week day;
 - (b) 2nd January, if New Year's Day falls on a Sunday;
 - (c) 3rd January, if New Year's Day falls on a Saturday;
 - (d) Good Friday;
 - (e) Easter Monday;
 - (f) the first Monday in May;
 - (g) the last Monday in May;
 - (h) the day scheduled as Senior Race Day as part of the Isle of Man Tourist trophy motorcycle races;
 - (i) 5th July, if a week day;
 - (j) 6th July, if 5th July falls on a Sunday;
 - (k) 7th July, if 5th July falls on a Saturday;
 - (l) the last Monday in August;
 - (m) 25th December, if a weekday;
 - (n) 26th December, if a weekday;

- (o) 27th December, if Christmas Day falls on a Saturday or a Sunday;
and
 - (p) 28th December, if 26th December falls on a Saturday or a Sunday.²
- (2) Despite paragraph (1), in 2022 –
- (a) the last Monday in May is not a bank holiday;
 - (b) Thursday 2nd June is a bank holiday; and
 - (c) Friday 3rd June is a bank holiday.³
- (3) [Revoked⁴

4 Revocation

The Bank Holidays (Amendment) Order 2010¹ is revoked.
