*Bank Holidays Act 1989***BANK HOLIDAYS ORDER 2019<sup>1</sup>***Laid before Tynwald: 16<sup>th</sup> July 2019**Coming into Operation: 1 January 2020*

The Treasury makes the following Order under section 1(2) of the Bank Holidays Act 1989.

**1 Title**

This Order is the Bank Holidays Order 2019.

**2 Commencement**

This Order comes into operation on 1 January 2020.

**3 Bank Holidays**

- (1) Subject to paragraph (2), the following days are bank holidays in every year —
- (a) New Year's Day, if a week day;
  - (b) 2<sup>nd</sup> January, if New Year's Day falls on a Sunday;
  - (c) 3<sup>rd</sup> January, if New Year's Day falls on a Saturday;
  - (d) Good Friday;
  - (e) Easter Monday;
  - (f) the first Monday in May;
  - (g) the last Monday in May;
  - (h) the day scheduled as Senior Race Day as part of the Isle of Man Tourist trophy motorcycle races;
  - (i) 5<sup>th</sup> July, if a week day;
  - (j) 6<sup>th</sup> July, if 5<sup>th</sup> July falls on a Sunday;
  - (k) 7<sup>th</sup> July, if 5<sup>th</sup> July falls on a Saturday;
  - (l) the last Monday in August;
  - (m) 25<sup>th</sup> December, if a weekday;
  - (n) 26<sup>th</sup> December, if a weekday;

- (o) 27<sup>th</sup> December, if Christmas Day falls on a Saturday or a Sunday;  
and
  - (p) 28<sup>th</sup> December, if 26<sup>th</sup> December falls on a Saturday or a Sunday.
- (2) In 2020, Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May is a bank holiday but Monday 4<sup>th</sup> May is not.

#### **4 Revocation**

The Bank Holidays (Amendment) Order 2010<sup>1</sup> is revoked.
