## EMERGENCY POWERS (ROAD TRANSPORT) (NO.2) REGULATIONS 2020<sup>1</sup>

*Laid before Tynwald: 7 April 2020*  
*Approved by Tynwald: 7 April 2020*  
*Coming into Operation: in accordance with regulation 2*

The Governor in Council, by Order<sup>1</sup>, makes the following Regulations under section 4 of the Emergency Powers Act 1936.

### 1 Title

These Regulations are the Emergency Powers (Road Transport) (No.2) Regulations 2020.

### 2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation immediately after they are made<sup>2</sup>.

### 3 Interpretation

In these Regulations —

“**the Act**” means the Road Transport Act 2001;

“**Coronavirus**” means severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV2); and

“**the Coronavirus Proclamation period**” means the period for which the Proclamation of Emergency dated 16 March 2020<sup>3</sup> is in operation.

<sup>1</sup> Section 4(1) specifies that “Where a proclamation of emergency has been made, and so long as such proclamation is in force, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, by Order, to make regulations ...”.

<sup>2</sup> By virtue of section 4(2) of the Emergency Powers Act 1936, the Regulations made under this Order must be laid before Tynwald within 7 days of being made and only continue in force beyond 7 days of being so laid if Tynwald passes a resolution to that effect.

**4 All Island Taxi Licensing**

A licence to operate in any part of the Island issued under section 29 of the Act is to be taken during the Coronavirus Proclamation period as to be a licence to operate anywhere in the Island.

**5 Suspension of Schedule 2 to the Act**

Schedule 2 to the Act is suspended until the end of the Coronavirus Proclamation period.

**6 Revocation**

The Emergency Powers (Road Transport) Regulations 2020<sup>4</sup> are revoked.
