Emergency Powers Act 1936

EMERGENCY POWERS (CORONAVIRUS) (SUSPENSION OF REGULAR SERVICE LICENCES) REGULATIONS 2020¹

Laid before Tynwald:

Coming into Operation: in accordance with regulation 2

The Governor in Council makes the following Regulations under section 4 of the Emergency Powers Act 1936.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Suspension of Regular Service Licences) Regulations 2020.

2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation immediately after they are made¹.

3 Interpretation

In these Regulations —

“**the Act**” means the Road Transport Act 2001;

“**Coronavirus**” means severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV2);

“**the Coronavirus Proclamation period**” means the period for which the following proclamations are in operation —

- (a) the Proclamation of Emergency dated 16 March 2020²; and
- (b) all subsequent consecutive Proclamations of Emergency that relate to the pandemic of Coronavirus (also known as COVID-19); and

“**regular service licences**” means licences issued under section 25 of the Act.

¹ By virtue of section 4(2) of the Emergency Powers Act 1936, the Regulations made under this Order must be laid before Tynwald within 7 days of being made and continue in force beyond 7 days of being so laid only if Tynwald passes a resolution to that effect.

4 Suspension of Regular Service Licences

During the Coronavirus Proclamation period, section 25 of the Act does not apply to the Department of Infrastructure trading as Bus Vannin.
