A PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL

WHEREAS there is a pandemic of Coronavirus (also known as Covid-19);

WHEREAS that disease is continuing to affect the Island and retains the capacity to cause serious damage to human health on the Island and the economic well-being of its inhabitants;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary for existing measures to control the disease to continue in operation;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 3 of the Emergency Powers Act 1936, the Governor in Council makes the following proclamation:

State of emergency

A state of emergency continues to exist on the Isle of Man.

Duration

This proclamation comes into operation at 12.01a.m. on 16th June 2020 and shall continue in operation until midnight on 15th July 2020 unless earlier revoked under section 3(3) of the Emergency Powers Act 1936.
