DOUGLAS PIERS RESTRICTED AREAS DESIGNATION ORDER 2020¹

Laid before Tynwald: 17 November 2020
Approved by Tynwald: 18 November 2020
Coming into operation: in accordance with article 2

The Department of Infrastructure makes the following Order under section 30 of the Harbours Act 2010.

1 Title

This Order is the Douglas Piers Restricted Areas Designation Order 2020.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation the day after it is made and ceases to have effect on 1st June 2021¹.

3 Restriction on access to Victoria Pier, the King Edward VIII Pier and the Battery Pier

To ensure public safety during scallop fishing season the areas of the Victoria Pier, the King Edward VIII Pier and the Battery Pier marked in red on the map in the Schedule shall be designated as restricted areas.

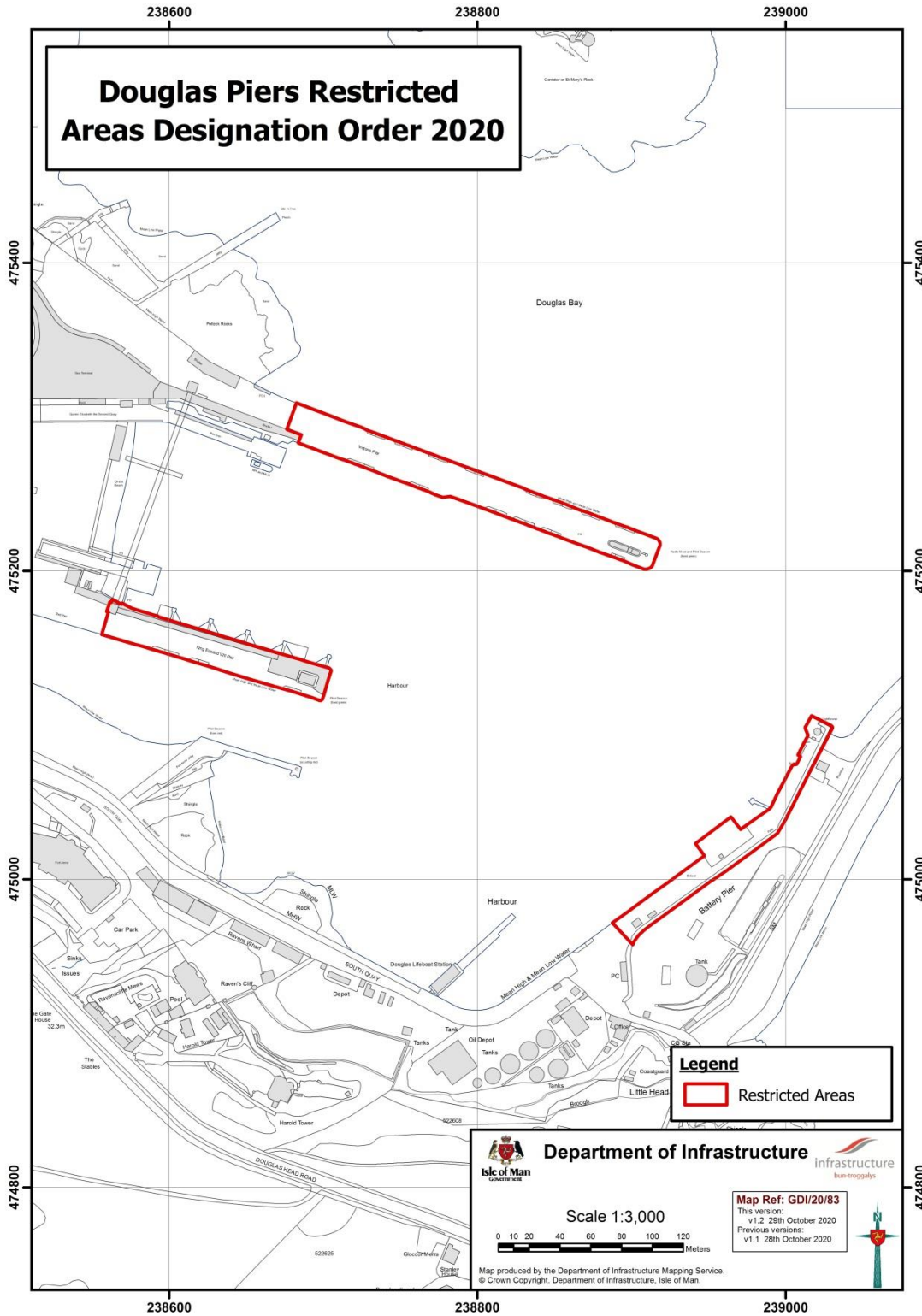

¹ By section 30(3) of the Harbours Act 2010 an order under subsection (1) must be laid before Tynwald as soon as practicable after it is made, and if Tynwald at the sitting at which the order is laid or at the next following sitting fails to approve it, it shall cease to have effect.
