## REGISTRATION OF ELECTORS ACT 2020 (APPOINTED DAY) ORDER 2021

*Made:**17 June 2021*

The Council of Ministers makes the following Order under section 2 of the Registration of Electors Act 2020.

### **1 Title**

This Order is the Registration of Electors Act 2020 (Appointed Day) Order 2021.

### **2 Interpretation**

In this Order —

- (a) “**the Act**” means the Registration of Electors Act 2020;
- (b) references to a section, subsection, paragraph or subparagraph (collectively, a “provision”) is a reference to the provision in the Act; and
- (c) references to a numbered section, subsection, paragraph or subparagraph is a reference to the provision so numbered in the Act.

### **3 Sections commenced in their entirety**

Sections 4, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, and 17 to 28 are commenced in their entirety.

### **4 Extent of commencement of section 5**

Section 5 is commenced subject to the following exceptions —

- (a) in subsection (1), the words “This duty is subject to subsections (2) and (3).” are not commenced;
- (b) subsection (2) is not commenced; and
- (c) in subsection (3), the words “Despite subsection (2),” are not commenced.

**5 Extent of commencement of section 6**

Subsections (3) and (5) of section 6 are commenced.

**6 Commencement of section 7**

Section 7 is commenced but, until subsections (1) and (2) of section 6 are commenced, must be read and construed as if the reference to “section 6(1) and (2)” were instead a reference to “the registration requirement”.

**7 Extent of commencement of section 10**

Section 10 is commenced with the exception of paragraph (a) of subsection (1).

**8 Extent of commencement of section 16**

The following provisions in section 16 are commenced —

- (a) subsection (1); and
- (b) paragraphs (a) and (c) of subsection (2).
