CURRENCY (PIONEERING WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE COLLECTION) £2 COIN ORDER 2021¹

Laid before Tynwald: 14 December 2021
Coming into operation in accordance with article 2

The Treasury makes the following Order under section 5(1) and (3) of the Currency Act 1992.

1 Title

This Order is the Currency (Pioneering Women's Suffrage Collection) £2 Coin Order 2021.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation on the day after it is made¹.

3 Interpretation

In this Order the “Pioneering Women’s Suffrage Collection coin” means a coin issued by the Treasury, which conforms to the requirements —

- (a) of article 4 regarding denomination and face value;
- (b) as to design and devices to be borne specified in Schedule 1; and
- (c) as to weight, composition, form and dimension, and the amount of variation from those matters allowed, specified in article 5 and Schedule 2.

4 Denomination and face value of the Pioneering Women’s Suffrage Collection coin

- (1) The denomination of the Pioneering Women’s Suffrage Collection coin is two pounds (£2).
- (2) The face value of the Pioneering Women’s Suffrage Collection coin is two pounds (£2).

¹ Under section 5(4) of the Currency Act 1992 a currency order (within the meaning given in section 5(1) of that Act) must be laid before Tynwald.

5 Weight, composition, form and dimensions of the Pioneering Women's Suffrage Collection coin and amount of variation from those matters allowed

- (1) The table in Schedule 2 specifies the weight, composition, form and dimensions of the Pioneering Women's Suffrage Collection coin and the amount of variation from those matters allowed, but subject to paragraph (2).
- (2) Despite any other provision of this Order, the Pioneering Women's Suffrage Collection coin that otherwise conforms to the specifications in the table in Schedule 2 may be minted at double the weight shown in Column 6 of the table as a *piedfort*.

SCHEDULE 1

DESIGN AND DEVICES TO BE BORNE

[Article 3(b)]

1 Obverse

The obverse of the Pioneering Women's Suffrage Collection coin shall bear —

- (a) the effigy of HM Queen Elizabeth by Jody Clark, for use on the coinage of the Crown Dependencies and the countries of the Commonwealth; and
- (b) the inscription 'QUEEN ELIZABETH II • ISLE OF MAN' and the year of issue,

as shown in figure 1.

2 Reverse

- (1) The reverse of the Pioneering Women's Suffrage Collection coin shall bear one of 4 designs as described in the following sub-paragraphs and as shown in figures 2 to 5.
- (2) The reverse of the Pioneering Women's Suffrage Collection coin 1 shall bear —
 - (a) an image of Catherine Callow's name being signed in the original Poll Books, the inscription 'PIONEERING WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE 1881' surrounds the coin; and
 - (b) the face value of the coin depicted by the inscription '2 POUNDS' at the bottom of the coin,

as shown in figure 2.

- (3) The reverse of the Pioneering Women's Suffrage Collection coin 2 shall bear —
- (a) an image of Margaret Kelvin's name being signed in the original Poll Books, the inscription 'PIONEERING WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE 1881' surrounds the coin; and
 - (b) the face value of the coin depicted by the inscription '2 POUNDS' at the bottom of the coin,

as shown in figure 3.

- (4) The reverse of the Pioneering Women's Suffrage Collection coin 3 shall bear —
- (a) an image of Eliza Jane Goldsmith's name being signed in the original Poll Books, the inscription 'PIONEERING WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE 1881' surrounds the coin; and
 - (b) the face value of the coin depicted by the inscription '2 POUNDS' at the bottom of the coin,

as shown in figure 4.

- (5) The reverse of the Pioneering Women's Suffrage Collection coin 4 shall bear —
- (a) an image of Esther Kee's name being signed in the original Poll Books, the inscription 'PIONEERING WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE 1881' surrounds the coin; and
 - (b) the face value of the coin depicted by the inscription '2 POUNDS' at the bottom of the coin,

as shown in figure 5.
