Minimum Wage Act 2001

MINIMUM WAGE (SINGLE HOURLY RATE) REGULATIONS 2022¹

*Approved by Tynwald: 15 February 2022
Coming into Operation in accordance with regulation 2*

The Department for Enterprise and the Treasury, acting jointly, makes the following Regulations under section 1(3) of the Minimum Wage Act 2001, having complied with section 1(4) of that Act.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Minimum Wage (Single Hourly Rate) Regulations 2022.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald, these Regulations come into operation on 31 March 2022¹.

3 Interpretation

In these Regulations “**pay reference period**” has the meaning given by regulation 10(1) of the Minimum Wage Regulations 2001².

4 The single hourly rate

In relation to any pay reference period beginning on or after 1 April 2022, the single hourly rate is £9.50.

5 Revocation

The Minimum Wage (Single Hourly Rate) Regulations 2019³ are revoked.
