HERITAGE TRAIL BRIDLE-PATH DESIGNATION ORDER 2023¹

Laid before Tynwald: 20 February 2024
Coming into operation: in accordance with paragraph 2

The Department of Infrastructure, after complying with the requirements of paragraph 1 of Schedule 2 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹, makes the following Order under section 91A(3) of the Highways Act 1986.

1 Title

This Order is the Heritage Trail Bridle-Path Designation Order 2023.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation on the day after it is made.

3 Designation of footpath to bridle-path

The footpath made up of the existing public rights of way specified in the Schedule is designated as a bridle-path.

SCHEDULE

BRIDLE-PATH TO BE DESIGNATED BY THIS ORDER

[Article 3]

- (1) The existing Public Right of Way No. 360 from Union Mills MR 358779 to St John's along the old railway track (Heritage Trail) to terminate at Station Road.
- (2) The existing Public Right of Way No. 362 from Station Road, St John's, northwesterly along the old railway track (Heritage Trail) to Mill Road, Peel.
