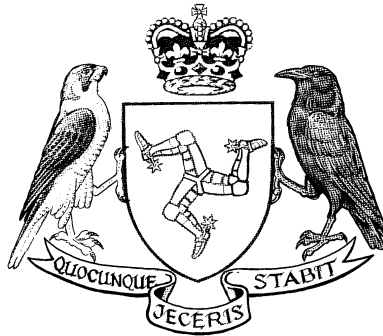

## AN ACT

to amend further the Payment of  
Members' Expenses Act 1989;  
and for connected purposes.

**B**E IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by  
and with the advice and consent of the Council and Keys in  
Tynwald assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Payment of Members' Expenses Act 1989 is amended  
as follows.

2. After section 1(2) add —

Section 1 amended

“(3) Unless the Treasury by order provides  
otherwise, a person who holds an office specified in  
subsection (2)(a) or (d) to (g) who is no longer a member  
of Tynwald, shall nevertheless be entitled to the sum  
for that office prescribed under this section.

(4) No person shall be entitled to an annual sum  
under this section in respect of membership of more  
than one Department.”.

3. In section 6(3) —

Section 6 amended

(a) after “subsection (1)” insert “or section 1(3),”; and

(b) after “where an order under subsection (1)” insert “or  
section 1(3)”.

4. After section 6 insert —

Section 6A inserted

“Continuation  
of office” **6A.** (1) Where a person holding an office specified in section 1(2)(f) ceases to be a member of Tynwald then, despite section 1(2)(b) of the Government Departments Act 1987 but subject to section 2(1) of that Act, he or she shall continue to hold that office until —

- (a) the next appointment to that office is made; or
- (b) in the case of a Department consisting of more than one member (other than the Minister), the Governor in Council decides not to fill that office.

(2) Where a person holding an office specified in section 1(2)(g) ceases to be a member of Tynwald he or she shall continue to hold that office until the next appointment to that office is made.

(3) A person who was a member of the Keys immediately before the dissolution of the Keys is deemed for the purposes of this Act to continue to be such a member until the returning officer makes a return of the writ in accordance with the election rules in Schedule 2 to the Representation of the People Act 1995.”

**5.** (1) For section 7(5) substitute —

“(5) An order under —

- (a) section 4(1)(a) or (b) specifying a body for the purposes of section 4;
- (b) section 5(1)(c)(iii) or (d) specifying a body for the purposes of section 5; or
- (c) section 11(2),

must be laid before Tynwald as soon as practicable after it is made.”

(2) Section 7(7) is repealed.

(3) Consequent on the repeal in subsection (2), section 3(2) of the Statute Law Revision Act 1992 is repealed.

**6.** This Act may be cited as the Payment of Members' Expenses (Amendment) Act 2010.
