AN ACT

to make provision consequential on the treaty concerning the accession of the Czech Republic, the Republic of Estonia, the Republic of Cyprus, the Republic of Latvia, the Republic of Lithuania, the Republic of Hungary, the Republic of Malta, the Republic of Poland, the Republic of Slovenia and the Slovak Republic to the European Union, signed at Athens on 16th April 2003.

WE, your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Council and Keys of the said Isle, do humbly beseech your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted, by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Council and Keys in Tynwald assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows (that is to say):—

Incorporation of the Treaty of Athens.

1. In section 1(1) of the European Communities (Isle of Man) Act 1973 [c. 14], in the definition of “the Treaties” or “the Community Treaties”, after paragraph (l), insert –

“and

- (m) the treaty concerning the accession of the Czech Republic, the Republic of Estonia, the Republic of Cyprus, the Republic of Latvia, the Republic of Lithuania, the Republic of Hungary, the Republic of Malta, the Republic of Poland, the Republic of Slovenia

and the Slovak Republic to the European Union, signed
at Athens on 16th April 2003;”.

Short title.

- 2.** This Act may be cited as the European Union (Accessions) Act 2004.
